

Claude Fernandes 1928 – 2015

It is with sadness we announce the passing away in London on 11 Sept. 2015 of Claude.

Born on 6th December 1928 in Nairobi, educated in India, Claude went back to Nairobi as a young man. He was very much involved with the Goan Institute in Nairobi, where he was treasurer for a while. He had a beautiful voice and sang contemporary songs of the time as well as Goan songs in Konkani.

He started his family in Nairobi and settled in London in 1970's, sacrificing the comfortable standard of living of Nairobi for the hard life in London. He made lots of friends at his place of work, Slade School of Art (University College, London); being artistic by nature, this was a place he loved. He had a beautiful handwriting for which he was chosen to write the Debenture Register of the Goan Association (UK).

In retirement he lived between Goa and London still being involved with the Goan community.

Wherever he was in his life, he was renowned for his principles, integrity and determination for the truth.
